LAWN MOWER DRIVING CONTEST

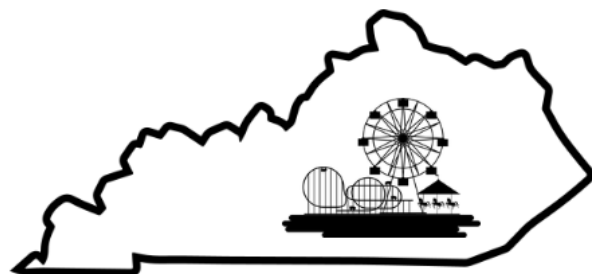
Dalton Foley competed in the 4-H Lawnmower Driving Contest at the Kentucky State Fair on Monday, August 21. He received a red ribbon!

Artwork should be dark enough to show up on a scan/copy. They may be designed using art techniques or scrapbooking techniques. Please no glitter or 3-dimensional designs as they do not copy well.

There will be up to 6 champion designs selected from the entries.

All artwork becomes the property of the Russell County 4-H Program, Russell Co. Cooperative Extension Service and may be used for service projects and/or fundraising projects for the Russell County 4-H Youth Development Program.
